FORMER international athlete and professional rugby league player Abi Ekoku has become a director of Harrogate-based business consultancy company the Andorra Group. Mr Ekoku, pictured, retired from playing professional sport in 1998 and stepped down as chief executive of the Bradford Bulls earlier this year.
